Fishguard Port Linkspan: Representative from Stena to attend to take questions on agenda item 4.

A representative from Stena attended online to give a short presentation and to take questions.

3. **Minutes of the previous meeting**

To approve the minutes of the previous meeting, held on Tuesday 1st July 2025, as a true and accurate record of the meeting.

It was resolved to accept the minutes as a true and accurate record. Proposed Cllr McCarney, seconded Cllr Morgan, unanimous.

4. HRO CAS-03457-C1Q0T7 - Fishguard Port linkspan:

Planning and Environmental Decisions Wales (PEDW) is examining the Harbour Revision Order (HRO) submitted by Fishguard and Rosslare Railways and Harbour Company. Review and discuss the Draft Harbour Revision Order and resolve a Town Council response and opinion for submission to PEDW.

Standing Orders were suspended to enable the representative from Stena to give his presentation and to take questions.

An online slide presentation was shared detailing the proposed works for Fishguard Port. The timeline was also explained with an overall project duration of approximately 9 months, and closure of the port required for an estimated 2/2.5 months. The speaker then welcomed questions from Councillors.

Standing Orders were adopted in order to resolve a response to the proposal.

It was resolved that the Town Council was in full support of the proposed replacement of the existing linkspan and the associated works required at Fishguard Port to enable completion of the project, therefore supporting the draft Revision Order and necessary Marine Licence. Proposed Cllr McCarney, seconded Cllr Murphy, unanimous.
