STANDING ORDERS WERE ADOPTED

1. Apologies.

To formally record apologies for absence and to record the attendance of Town Councillors.

2. Declarations of interest.

3. Minutes of the previous meeting

To approve the minutes of the previous meeting, held on Tuesday 3rd February 2026 as a true and accurate record of the meeting.

It was resolved to accept the minutes as a true and accurate record. Proposed Cllr Morgan, seconded Cllr McCarney, unanimous.

4. **A40 & A487 Trunk Roads Fishguard & Lower Town - 30mph Speed Limit Traffic Regulation Order**

Following the completion of the review undertaken in accordance with the *Setting 30mph Speed Limits on Restricted Roads* guidance, updated in July 2024, it has been concluded that 30mph is an appropriate speed limit for a section of the A40 & A487 Trunk Roads within Fishguard & Lower Town. A draft Traffic Regulation Order plan has been produced displaying the proposed extent of the 30mph speed limit. Initial views and feedback on the proposals in advance of the official orders consultation is being sought from the Town Council. Consider the information provided and resolve a Town Council response.

The Town Council discussed the two identified locations for the proposed change of speed limit from 20mph to 30mph and the following resolution was agreed:

1) A40 (Pendre 236 metres): It was resolved to object to the proposed increase in speed limit on this section and that the limit be retained at 20mph. In addition, was the observation that a 40mph limit should be introduced from the A40 roundabout to the start of the 20mph stretch. Proposed Cllr Churchill, seconded Cllr McCarney, majority in favour.

2) A487 (Lower Town Fishguard 550metres): It was resolved to support the proposed increase in speed limit in this section from 20mph to 30mph, with the observation that a preferred exact location of the change in speed be further out of Lower Town (what3word location costumes.daunting.unsecured). Proposed Cllr S Hughes, seconded Cllr McCarney, unanimous.
